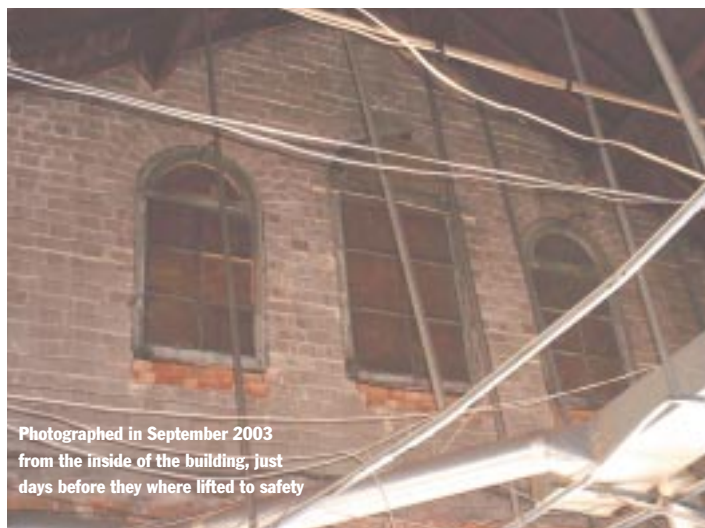


# Clutterbuck & Rutter save the windows
